Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who is eligible for the NHSE CPD Funding?

A: Every registered:

- Nurse
- Nursing Associate
- Midwife
- Allied Health Professional (AHP) listed below

Below is the list of 14 professions that are included in the AHP group:

The offers detailed in this document are utilising the Humber and North Yorkshire (HNY) general practice funding allocation and are open to eligible staff employed by a practice or PCN in HNY.

Q: Why aren't other roles included?

The included list has been mandated by NHSE in line with the governmental budget allocation for CPD, this remains the same since its introduction in 2020-21. Training hubs have fed back to NHSE practice concerns around why other wider workforce roles such as HCAs, GPAs and PAs are not currently included, in the hope they will be considered in review for future year's allocations.

Q: Can I access multiple offers?

A: Yes, you can access funded training within any of the detailed categories, up to the limit of each category:

- BiteSize CPD webinars unlimited
- Rotherham Respiratory courses up to one per person
- NB Plus subscription unlimited access once subscribed (please subscribe by 30/11/23)
- Haxby Group Training courses up to two per person

This is to ensure fair access. For limited categories a waiting list system will be in place for requests of further places above the category limit. If funding allows later in the year we will then be able to offer additional places on a first-come-first-served basis from the waiting list.

Q: How do I access the offers?

A: Each offer can be accessed via the respective pathway:

Q: I'm already on the Rotherham Respiratory waiting list for a course, do I need to re-apply?

A: No, Rotherham Respiratory will shortly be in touch with you to offer a funded place on your requested course. If you requested more than one they will ask your preference.

Rotherham Respiratory courses were previously funded via Workforce Transformation Funding (WTF, previously known as SSPRD) which has now run out for 2023-24. They have kept all requests on a waiting list until further funding has become available and these will now transfer across as CPD funding requests.

Q: Can we block book a group of staff for the BiteSize CPD webinars?

A: The BiteSize CPD webinars can be booked via the Medtribe platform, links to book each session can be found here: BiteSize CPD Webinars

The platform is designed for individuals to create a login and book their own places, so they can then manage their bookings, receive joining links and information, log their attendance, and receive a certificate afterwards. We recommend each member of staff books their own places, rather than someone else booking on their behalf.

Dates will frequently be added throughout the year so please check back regularly.

Q: Can I request a webinar topic not already listed? How will I know when the topics I want are running?

A: If you would like to request a topic not already included in the BiteSize CPD webinar list please contact us on training@haxbygroup.co.uk. We'd be happy to hear from you and if there are common requests we can look to add in any topics with enough demand.

Throughout the year dates will be added regularly and there will be webinars available most weeks. Some topics will run more than once subject to demand, as places are limited to 30 in each session. You can see what's coming up by regularly checking here: <u>BiteSize CPD Webinars</u>, where dates will be listed at least two months ahead.

Q: I already claimed my £333 individually as I wanted to source my own training – can I also access these funded options?

A: Unfortunately not, the choice to claim £333 to use independently was an alternative option to accessing these centrally funded options. This is because there would not be enough funding for individuals to take advantage of both options.

Q: If I did not already choose to claim my £333 individually during the PCN returns phase, can I still opt to do that now?

A: Unfortunately in order to manage allocation of the limited budget based on PCN returns, this option was only open during the PCN returns phase (August 2023).
