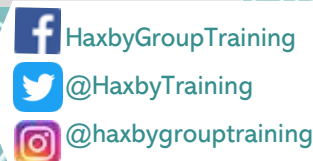

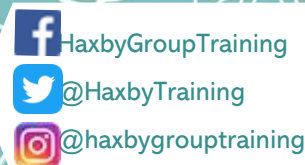

Training in clinical skills covers theory and simulated practice. Following training supervised practice must be completed in the clinical setting, the student will be issued with competencies to complete before receiving a certificate. A competent registered nurse must be responsible for confirming that the student has gained sufficient practical competency before independent practice.

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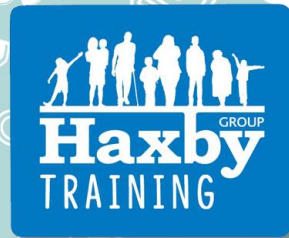
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IMMUNISATIONS AND VACCINATIONS



INITIAL IMMUNISATION TRAINING FOR NURSES

£150

- Full day - Suitable for Nurses new to immunisation
- Competencies will be issued to complete in practice following the training
- Includes: Theory and practical training, immunisation history, immunology and theory, types of vaccines and compositions, vaccine preventable diseases and epidemiology, current issues and controversies, communicating with patients and parents, legal aspects, storage and handling, correct administration, dosage and reconstitution, contraindications and precautions, pregnancy, documentation, strategies for improving immunisation rates, adverse reactions, anaphylaxis and adverse events
- Covering: Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Haemophilus influenzae type B (HIB), Poliomyelitis, Meningococcal, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Rotavirus infection, Influenza, Pneumococcal, Shingles



INITIAL IMMUNISATION TRAINING FOR HCAs

£150

- Full day - Suitable for HCAs new to immunisation
- ***Please note: Public Health England recommended only HCAs who have achieved education and training to Level 3 or equivalent with at least 2 years' experience as a HCA should be considered for immunisation training***
- Competencies will be issued to complete in practice following the training
- Includes: Theory and practical training, immunisation history, immunology and theory, types of vaccines and compositions, storage and handling, dosage and reconstitution, vaccine preventable diseases and epidemiology, correct administration, precautions and contraindications, legal aspects, documentation, adverse reactions, anaphylaxis and adverse events
- Covering: Influenza, Pneumococcal, Shingles, B12



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IMMUNISATIONS AND VACCINATIONS

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IMMUNISATION UPDATE FOR NURSES

£70

- Half day - Suitable for nurses experienced in immunisation and requiring an update
- Includes: Immunology, types of vaccines and composition, storage and handling, precautions, pregnancy, contraindications, legal aspects, documentation, adverse reactions, anaphylaxis and adverse events



IMMUNISATION UPDATE FOR HCAs

£70

- Half day - Suitable for HCAs experienced in immunisation and requiring an update
- Includes: Immunology, types of vaccines and composition, dosage and reconstitution, storage and handling, correct administration, precautions, contraindications, legal aspects, documentation, adverse reactions, anaphylaxis and adverse events



ANNUAL FLU UPDATE

£60

- 2 hours - Suitable for Nurses and HCAs needing an annual update for flu season
- Covering adult and child flu vaccination, including: vaccination content, guidelines, eligibility, contraindications and anaphylaxis

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FEMALE HEALTH

£80

- Half day - Suitable for Practice Nurses or Nurse Associates new to primary care or those Nurses who wish to expand their knowledge in Female Health.
- Includes: An overview in anatomy and physiology, the menstrual cycle and common menstrual disorders seen in primary care including dysmenorrhoea, amenorrhoea, PMS and PMDD. The training will consist of theoretical knowledge, practice-based scenarios and the NICE guidelines encompassing common gynaecological conditions, abnormal discharge, common and sexually transmitted infections and the role of the nurse in primary care.



CONTRACEPTION

£80

- Half day - Suitable for Practice Nurses or Nurse Associates new to primary care or those Nurses who wish to expand their knowledge in Contraception.
- Includes: An overview in effective counselling, Gillick competence/Fraser guidelines and legal issues surrounding contraception and the delivery of services. The session will cover method specific contraception including long-acting-reversible-contraception (LARC), mode of action, health risks and non-contraceptive benefits with particular focus on initiation of contraception, reviews and guidance related to missed pills or late contraceptive use and pregnancy risk in line with the Faculty of Sexual Reproductive Healthcare guidance. The session will aim to promote an understanding of emergency contraception and when to initiate. The training will consist of theoretical knowledge, practice-based scenarios and application of the UK medical eligibility criteria (UKMEC).
